N. had expressed their inability to attend the meeting due to some unavoidable circumstances, and therefore leave of absence was granted to them. Item Details

Item No I

To read and confirm the minutes of third meeting of Academic Council held in the meeting half of institute on 30/04/2016.

1.1 The minutes of the fourth meeting of Academic Council held on 30/04/2016, were read and Prof. Dr. M. H. Nerkar pointed that his name is included in the list of present mombers as well as in the list of the members who are granted the leave of absence and he was present for the meeting. Therefore; his name should be deleted from the list of the members who are granted the leave of absence for fourth AC meeting. Academic Council confirmed the minutes of fourth meeting unanimously with the referred modification.

Item No 2

To note and approve the action taken by institute on the agenda points discussed and resolved in the earlier meetings of Academic Council.

2.1 The action taken by institute on the agenda points discussed and resolved in the earlier meetings of Academic Council were briefed by Dean Academics Prof. S. O. Dahad.

2.2 The same were noted and approved.

Item No 3

To discuss and suggest suitable modifications in the examination rules specifically revaluation of ESF of theory courses i. e. Rule No 13,5 and Challenge to Revaluation i. e, Rule No 14.2. (Agenda point to be presented by Hon. Member Secretary of Examination Committee - CoE)

3.1 Dean academics Prof. S. O. Dahad briefed the academic council about the examination rule number 13.5 and 14.2 and other related rules,

3.2 Principal Dr. R. P. Borkar briefed about discussion and recommendation of APEC.



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3.3 After detailed discussion on above two rules; it was unanimously resolved to modify above rules as given bellow.

13.5 End Semester Examination (ESE) of Theory Courses: Revaluation of ESE of theory courses shall be carried out as per following guidelines

- The aspiring candidate shall apply for revaluation to AEC in prescribed format by paying requisite fees within 03 working days (02 working days in case of makeup examination) (both days inclusive) or as specified in academic calendar from the day of display of marks and obtain the acknowledgement.
- Assistant CoE (Post-Examination) shall collect and compile all received applications of revaluation, Prepare course wise bundles of re-masked answer papers.
- Assistant CoE (Post-Examination) shall issue appointment order to examiners for revaluation in consultation with Chairman, examination committee, in general examiner appointed for revaluation should be other than the first examiner and senior most faculty member in the panel suggested by respective BoS.
- The marks assigned by evaluator appointed for revaluation shall be the final marks (i. e. marks after revaluation) provided that the change in marks is more than 5 % of prescribed total marks for ESE or result of that course of the candidate can change from fail to pass. This facility shall not be available after grades are finalized.
- Revaluation work shall be completed within 7 days (03 days in case of makeup examination) from the last day of receiving application for revaluation.

14.2 Challenge to Revaluation:

- Any student can challenge to revaluation i. e. he/she can apply for re-revaluation of his/her answer book within 03 working days (02 working days in case of makeup examination) (both days inclusive) after receiving photo copy of said answer book.
- The marks assigned by evaluator appointed for re-revaluation (challenge to revaluation) shall be the final marks (i. c. marks after revaluation) provided that the change in marks is more than 5 % of prescribed total marks for ESE or result of that course of the candidate can change from fail to pass. This facility shall not be available after grades are finalized.
- Re-revaluation work shall be completed within 5 days (03 days in ease of makeup examination) from the last day of receiving application for re-revaluation.
- 3.4 In addition Prof. A. M. Dondardive suggested to remove ambiguity in the punishment to the students who are involved in use of unfair means in the ESE. After detailed discussion it was unanimously resolved that Chairman AC is authorised to make suitable changes in the rule in consultation with Dean Academics and Dean Students' affair. Accordingly; the rule "IB.6 Punishments to Students" is modified as given below.

18.6 Punishments to Students: In every case, where a candidate appearing for an examination is found using or attempting to use Unfair Means / Malpractice at the examination following punishment may be imposed by Discipline and Redress Committee.
